Robert VINCENT



Joined the Otolaryngology group of the Causse Ear Clinic in Colombiers, France on January 1991.

Otolaryngologist surgeon with special interest on stapes surgery and ossicular reconstruction of the middle ear. He has performed more than 7500 operations for otosclerosis, more than 4000 operations for ossicular reconstruction and more than 260 operations for congenital malformation of the ossicular chain. Honorary Fellow of the Royal College of Surgeons of Edinburgh (UK) and Honorary Member of the Indian Society of Otolaryngology.

Member of several ENT societies such as the American Academy of Otolaryngology-Head and Neck Surgery (AAO-HNS), the European Academy of Otolaryngology & Neuro-Otology (EAONO), the Otosclerosis Study Group, the Prosper Meniere Society, the Mediterranean Society of Otolaryngology and the Politzer Society. Founder and General of the Live International Otolaryngology Network (LION: www.lion-web.org) which is promoting free HD videoconferencing advanced e-learning program on middle ear surgery. Live surgery is broadcasted every year from several well known Institutions worldwide including the Causse Ear Clinic.

He was Instructor at the AAO-HNS for many years. On October 4 2009 he has been awarded by the Board of Directors of the AAO-HNS a certificate of honor for exceptional services in the scientific program continuing education courses and instructional courses of this Society.

He is on the editorial board of several scientific journals such as the Otolaryngology & Neurotology Journal, the Journal of the Mediterranean Society of Otolaryngology, and also serves as a reviewer for a number of professional publications.

Since 21 years he runs a annual advanced otology course in June at the Causse Ear Clinic where delegates from all parts of the world are participating every year.

He is a yearly invited guest speaker and guest surgeon in many countries worldwide and has designed several middle ear prostheses and published new techniques in ossicular reconstruction.

He has published many publications on middle ear surgery in several scientific journals and wrote chapters in several books on surgical technique in Otolaryngology.

Christopher ALDREN



Chris Aldren is an ear surgeon based in Windsor. He has a particular interest in stapes surgery, ossiculoplasty and mastoid obliteration. He is honorary consultant otologist to Great Ormond Street Hospital, London.

He is past President of the British Society of Otolaryngology, past President of LION Live International Otolaryngology Network and President of the Royal Society of Medicine, Otolaryngology section. He is the editor of the otology section of Scott Brown's textbook of Otorhinolaryngology, Head and Neck Surgery. Outside of medicine he is a keen violinist leading the European Doctors Orchestra. He is on the advisory council of the London Philharmonic Orchestra.

John OATES



John was a Consultant ENT Surgeon from 1991 until retiring recently. His first decade was directed towards clearing the longest wait for mastoid surgery (152 weeks) in the UK! The strategy and methods required for this subsequently enabled him to concentrate on the more enjoyable facets of our specialty running practical courses and developing equipment and techniques, mainly aimed at stapes and ossicular surgery.

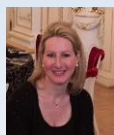
John met Robert Vincent in a bar in 1991 and over the next 15 years they travelled extensively together particularly within Europe, together with North and South America. John met Chris in 1993 and, subsequently, both John and Robert taught regularly on Chris Aldren's very successful International Course in Windsor and John headed up the International Faculty at the Causse Clinic Course held in June every year since it started in the 1990s.

His main focus has always been on teaching practical skills. Together with Robert and a Welsh colleague they set up the first transmissions of live surgery in 2002-2003 from the British Academic Conference in Birmingham, and Wales. A subsequent transmission from Paris was a disaster but fortunately the big Dutchman Wilko Grolman joined the group and LION was formed. Wilko has been pivotal ever since.

Whilst not an Academic John has represented his colleagues at a Regional, National and International levels for many years and was an invited appointment by the UK Government to advise and oversee commercial hearing aid dispensing in the UK, as a Board Member of The Hearing Aid Council.

At a European level after discovering "financial discrepancies" in EUFOS in 2003 he became pivotal in folding EUFOS and running the EAORL-HNS. He subsequently held 3 terms of office, two as Treasurer, at the newly formed CEORL-HNS which now has over 50000 members. He was asked to stand for President but Brexit canned that!

Olivia WHITESIDE



Olivia qualified from St Bartholomew's and The Royal London Hospital Medical School in 1998 during which time she also gained a first class honors degree in an intercalated BSc in Neuroscience at University College London.

She undertook higher surgical training in ENT in the Oxford region. During this time, she was awarded the Royal Society of Medicine Gold medal for achieving the top mark in Great Britain and Ireland for her ENT fellowship (FRCS ORL-HNS) examination. She spent the final year of her training as the inaugural Oxford Advanced Otolaryngology Fellow, specialising in treatment and surgery for diseases of the ear.

Olivia has been an ENT Consultant since July 2011, leaving the NHS in October 2021 to work solely in private practice. She sees patients with all types of ear, nose and throat disorders, she has a particular interest in the ear, in particular cholesteatoma, tinnitus, dizziness, childhood hearing problems, reconstruction of the bones of hearing and Eustachian tube disorders. She has published numerous articles in various medical journals.
